

Firearm Safety for Everyone



Today, you came in for your health check-up.

Don't forget your home safety check-up. 

Responsible community members look out for each other.

Secure firearm storage can prevent unauthorized access, such as by intruders, children, or loved ones who may be struggling with stress, suicidal thoughts, substance use, or other unexpected challenges.



Even if you don't have a firearm, many homes do.

Like other everyday safety conversations, **you can stay prepared by talking about firearm safety with family, friends, and neighbors:**

With the adults you live with:

"Let's make sure our firearms are securely stored in quick-access safes so intruders won't get ahold of them."

With other parents:

"Before our kids' playdate, will you confirm any firearms in your home are secured?"

With your parents and siblings:

"Our relative was recently diagnosed with Alzheimer's. We should sit down as a family and talk about securely storing any firearms in our homes."

With family members:

"Our son has been feeling really down lately. Let's make sure our firearms are stored securely to help keep him safe."

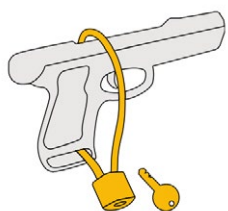

There are many options, with various shapes, sizes, prices, and lock types (key, mechanical, combination, fingerprint, etc.).

Cable locks (for unloaded firearms)

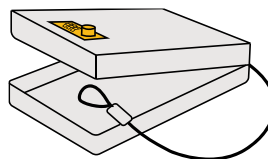


Cable lock
(Free)

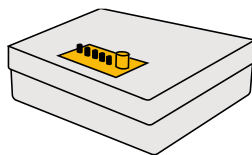
Lockable case, box, or safe (including quick-access)

(\$35+)



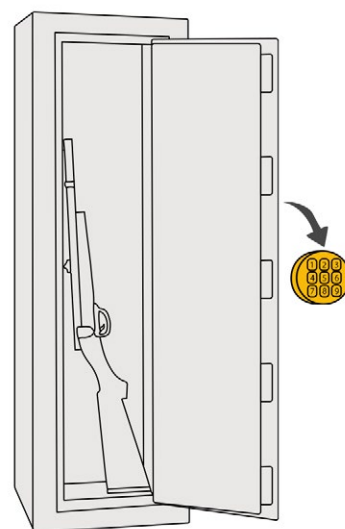
Combination
